General

1. Perennial forb growing from a bulb to 0.3m

Geography and Habitat

1. Native: Europe
2. Habitat
 - Requires moist soil
 - Open fields, grassy areas, along railroad tracks, roadsides, rocky grazed slopes, shaded banks, alluvial soils in wooded riparian zones
