General

1. Freshwater bivalve growing from 4—4.6mm in length

Geography and Habitat

1. Native: Holarctic species found in Eurasia (Iceland, Scandinavia, France, Germany, Belgium, the former USSR territories, UK)
2. Habitat:
 - Rivers, canals, and streams of good water quality in its native range
 - Lakes and large rivers in North America
 - Depths up to 20m
 - Typically associated with silt, mud, and sand assemblages
