General

1. Perennial forb growing to 3m
2. Globally distributed

Geography and Habitat


1. Native: North America, Europe, Asia, Northern Africa
2. Habitat
 - Coastland, estuarine habitats, lakes, riparian zones, water courses, wetlands
 - Wet, saturated, or flooded substrates
 - Tolerates slightly brackish water
 - Prefers soil with high organic matter; tolerates fine texture mineral soils
 - Intolerant of shade
