



Didemnum candidum

White didemnid (Tunicate)

Threat scores

1. Ecological impact
 - Fouling organism; ecological impact unstudied, but spatial competition in shallow water and fouling communities is likely
2. Invasive potential
 - A fouling organism requiring assisted transport to expand alien range
3. Geographic extent
 - Locally patchy

Geography and Habitat

1. Native: Unclear, likely Indo-Pacific and/or Red Sea
2. Introduced: Hawai'i
3. Habitats
 - Coral reefs, fouling communities, benthic
 - Shallow water, primarily in the fouling community of protected harbors and embayment, but also on the reefs in Kaneohe Bay
 - Grows on all substrates, even living animals and algae
